The Central Ohio River Business Association ([CORBA](#)) in partnership with the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments ([OKI](#)) has a shared vision to heighten awareness of Ohio River commerce as an important component of our regional transportation network. With a broad public-private economic development partnership, groundwork was laid in 2015 by expanding the designated port boundaries for the *Ports of Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky* to better highlight barge volume and capacity in our region on a macro level.

We need now, however, to confirm the e-mail address for the appropriate person relative to each site. You are receiving this e-mail based on records collected from various sources. Once completed and posted online for public use, the site will help our industry, your company brand(s), and your bottom line by raising visibility with-in our expanding market.
