Course Description

Damage Assessment and the Declaration Process is intended to serve as a vehicle to share proven damage assessment strategies and practices as well as to enhance teamwork and coordination among the agency's damage assessment team. The course utilizes scenarios and exercises to highlight key issues and facilitate discussion. The concluding functional exercise is intended to allow participants an opportunity to apply the information provided during the course in a controlled environment. **Class will start at 8:00 AM EST and end at 4:00 PM EST each day.**

Student Criteria

This course is open to all personnel whose organization have responsibility for Damage Assessment. There are no Pre-Requisites for this course.

Special Notes

A **MINIMUM # of twenty (20)** advance student registrations is **REQUIRED** and must be received by **November 11, 2022**. A **MAXIMUM fifty (50)** will be accepted. **COVID-19 mitigation efforts such as social distancing, monitoring for symptoms, sanitizing and hand washing remain in effect regardless of vaccination status.
